Application Information and Instructions

The Memphis Heritage Trail Summer Teacher Institute provides 6-12 educators with the opportunity to engage in intensive study and discussion of important topics and issues relative to the African American experience in Memphis. It includes direct experiences in the interpretation of significant historical and cultural sites and the use of archival and other primary evidence.

Educators collaborate to use the best available scholarship to develop a curriculum relative to places, events, and people significant to the Trail and the Civil Rights Movement in Memphis. Educators benefit by gaining a sense of the importance of historical and cultural places, by making connections between the workshop content and what they teach, and by developing individual teaching and/or research materials. The curriculum will be available in a user-friendly, online format on the MHT website.

Selection, Deadlines, and Notification

Fifty (50) educators will be selected to participate in the Summer Teacher Institute. A selection committee (consisting of the project director, one of the project scholars, and a veteran teacher) will review all properly completed applications. It is important to address each of the following factors in the Relevant Experience section of the application: 1) your professional background; 2) your interest in the subject of the workshop; 3) your special perspectives, skills, or experiences that would contribute to the workshop; and 4) how the experience would enhance your teaching or school.

Notification of Acceptance: May 1, 2019

Successful applicants will be notified of their selection on May 1, 2019 and have until May 10, 2019 to accept or decline the offer.

Stipend and Conditions of Award

Educators selected to participate in MHT Summer Teacher Institute will receive a \$500 stipend.

Participants are required to attend all scheduled meetings and to engage fully as professionals in all project activities. The Institute will meet Monday - Friday from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Participants who do not complete the full tenure of the project will receive a reduced stipend. At the end of the Institute, participants will be asked to complete an assessment of their experience, especially in terms of its value to their personal and professional development.
